

Age Requirements for the Horseshoe Resort Downhill Bike Park 2011

Valid ID will be required for proof of age. Riders 17 and under who do not have a waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian will not be permitted to purchase a trail pass or rentals.

Riders under the age of 10 years:

- Cross-country trail pass or lift access only while accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Riders age 10 to 12 years:

- For cross country trails, must ride with an adult 21 years or older
- For bike park, must complete the guided orientation
- For bike park, must ride with an adult 21 years or older

Riders age 13 to 17 years:

- Must complete the Guided Orientation.

All downhill riders 17 and under are required to wear a full face helmet and full armour (arms, legs, chest and back protection). These are available to rent for \$30 for the entire package (full-faced helmet, pressure suit and leg guard)

Rider Assessment

Ages: All riders 17 years of age and under

Cost: Free

Length: Less than 40 minutes

Assessment: Basic braking, cornering and decision-making ability on blue and green terrain. Riders must possess basic fundamental riding skills (brake use, decision at speed and ability to overcome trail features)

Guided Orientation

Ages: All ages

Cost: \$12

Length: 45 minutes

Includes: Tour of the Bike Park, explanation of signage and basic DH riding procedure and trail etiquette

Note: Strongly recommended for inexperienced Downhill riders to participate in a guided orientation of the trails
