

What is it?

Horseshoe Adventure Park is a new "Adventure" Themed area being created at Horseshoe Resort in the Area that the Winter Tubing operation currently resides. The Adventure Park will be a year round outdoor Park with a combination of fun unique attractions and leisure areas for relaxing and enjoying the breathtaking beauty of Georgian Valley's hidden gem, the Copeland forest.

Where is it?

Horseshoe Adventure Park is located in beautiful Horseshoe Valley inside the Horseshoe Resort grounds. It is located right off of Hwy 400 North on Horseshoe Valley Road only a short one hour drive north of Toronto and 15 minutes north of Barrie.

What types of Attractions will be in the Horseshoe Adventure Park?

Our winter tubing has been the building block and flagship product of the Adventure Park. In addition to winter tubing, we will offer summer tubing, Southern Ontario's longest zip line, climbing wall, zorbing (both harness and water), skate-park, downhill mountain biking and mini golf. We will also offer covered picnic areas, food and beverage outlets, washrooms, dog-park and change room facilities.

Who would enjoy Horseshoe Adventure Park?

The Park is built for both families and teens in mind. There will be many areas for children to play and enjoy the outdoors as well as seating areas for parents to observe their children or just rest and relax. There are adrenaline pumping attractions such as the Zip line and harness zorbing but most of our attractions are geared toward a moderate thrill level that people of all ages would enjoy. There are some height requirements that will be considered in most of the attractions but will vary so by attraction so we will ensure the height requirements are clearly posted.

What is the cost to play in the Adventure Park?

The attractions in the Park will have a cost associated with them but if you want to come into the Park just to enjoy the surroundings, you will be able to do so. Each attraction will have an individual cost however there will be an All Day Access ticket as well so you can enjoy as many attractions in one day as often as you like. We will also be able to offer package deals with accommodations if you are looking to stay overnight at our hotel located on site.

When will Horseshoe Adventure Park open?

On Thursday July 1st, Horseshoe Adventure Park will celebrate its Grand open during our Canada Day celebrations at Horseshoe Resort where we celebrate our Nations birthday with our Oro-Medonte neighbours. We will have a few private days for media, ski/golf members, employee's and their families prior to the Grand opening that will be announced in the near future.

Horseshoe Adventure Park Facts

Horseshoe Adventure Park offers Ontario's only zorb ride and is the only fully operational zorb park in Canada.

- zorbing or "sphering" can include harness and water:
- Harness zorbing involves rolling downhill in a rubberized sphere with an air cushion of two feet between the ground and harnessed participant, making it completely safe
- Water zorbing involves sliding around freely in a shallow pool of water while contained within a rubberized sphere

Horseshoe Adventure Park has Southern Ontario's longest zipline and only Zip Flyer.

- A zipline consists of a pulley suspended on a cable mounted on an incline, designed to enable a user propelled by gravity to cross from the top to the bottom of the inclined cable, by holding on or attaching to the freely moving pulley
- A Zip Flyer is a high-tech zipline that allows the rider to sit in a harnessed chair
- A Zip Flyer allows those seeking adventure to fly through the air at speeds of up to 45kms an hour
